



## 36th INTERNATIONAL TABLE TENNIS YOUTH CHAMPIONSHIPS OF LUXEMBOURG

Luxembourg-Kirchberg, June 10<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup>, 2022

### Prospectus

**Organizer :** Luxembourg Table Tennis Federation (F.L.T.T.)

**Venue:** Centre National Sportif et Culturel „d’Coque“

**Date:** 10<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> June, 2022

**Participants:** Each delegation wishing to participate should enter one (1) participant in each category. Participation in at least six (6) of the eight (8) categories is mandatory with a minimum of entries in at least three (3) girls categories and in at least three (3) boys categories. Delegations whose entries conform with this requirement are entitled to additional entries, with however a limit of two (2) entries per category and up to ten (10) players maximum per delegation in total.

As the number of participating players per category is limited to a maximum of 24 players, acceptance of entries will be done on "first come, first serve" basis.

**We strongly recommend to send your preliminary entry form as soon as possible, at the latest for March 15th, 2022.**

Priority will be given to those entries announced by a preliminary entry in due time.

#### **System of play:**

##### **Qualifying stage:**

Each category will be played in groups of 5-6 players each.

The best 3 players of each group will advance to table A.

The players 4-6 in the groups will advance to table B.

##### **Final stage:**

The final stage is divided in two tables, A and B. Both tables will be played in double k.o. system for all positions.

Table A will determine the places 1-12 of the category, whereas table B will be for the places 13-24.

##### **Remark:**

The playing system may be subject to changes depending on the total number of entries per category.

All matches are played best of 5. (sets to 11)
